Covenant House Texas is a faith-based organization committed to giving homeless youth a safe haven, absolute respect, unconditional love, and a path to lasting independence. In partnership with the community, we are the voice for homeless youth.

Since our founding 40 years ago, Covenant House Texas remains the only organization in Houston exclusively serving youth 18-24 who are homeless, trafficked, or at risk. Covenant House Texas is inclusive, intentional and impactful.

Our donors allow us to meet the emerging needs of our youth and accelerate our work. Our comprehensive youth-driven programming is centered on unconditional love, absolute respect and relentless engagement.

Every young person comes to us at a different stage of development and level of need. Some youth arrive needing immediate safety, others have been couch-surfing for months, and many have found themselves alone after aging out of foster care. All of them have experienced some form of trauma throughout their childhood/adolescent years, or as a result of the period of homelessness. Every single youth is welcomed and cared for individually at a pace commensurate with their personal development.
